			Laxative of choice daily PRN constipation				
			Dalmane 15 mg PO HS PRN sleep				
			Librium 25 mg PO Q4 hours PRN CIWA greater than or equal to 8. Call for additional doses.				
			Nicotine patch 21 mg topically daily for 4 days if patient smokes. Call for further orders if patient still hospitalized.
